Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Priscilla Buson the plantation wherein I now live also the use profit & income of all my personal Estate while she remains my widow in Order bring up & Educate the Children, but in Case she should Marry Again my will is she shall have the use of One Third Only

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Son John A Buson the tract wherein I now live at the death or marriage of my widow

Item I Give & bequeath unto my three Sons Jaso, Joel & Martin W Buson my Bullock Tract of Land Also a piece of meadow ground joining Thos Sanders to be equally divided between them

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Two Daughters Jane & Annisha Buson when they shall become of Age Four Hundred Dollars a piece to be made of my personal Estate - I also will unto my wife Priscilla my Black Woman Moriah during her widowhood

And Lastly I Constitute and appoint & make my beloved wife Priscilla Buson Executrix & Thomas Sanders Executor jointly of this my

last will & Testament - In witness whereof I have to these presents set my hand & Seal this 27th day of April in the Year of Our Lord
