Thirdly, I give to my daughter Mary Coble the balance of my tract of land. I live on also I give to my daughter Mary two cows.

I also give to my son Martin my waggon and a cow and a beef.

And I appoint my son Martin Coble and my son in law Eliha Lewis to Executors of this my last will and Testament.

In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal to this my last will and Testament the third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen.
