also I give her my Beautiful bed and all that is in
it also one feather bed and furniture

8th I give unto my son Aaron Clemer the Wallance
of that tract of land wherow Aaron now lives
also the tract of land wherow Aaron lived at the
Death of my wife also the lands very at the
Death of Sarah Clemer.

9th I allow Thomas Clemer my Grandson to live
with my wife until Fred I then give him one Horse
10th I allow John Clemer my Grand Son to live with
my wife until Fred I then give him one Horse
