2nd I give unto my Son Thomas Cramer the sum of one Dollar,

3rd I give to my Son Dudley Cramer the sum of one Dollar.

4th I give unto the Heirs of Mrs Cramer one Dollar,

5th I give unto the Heirs of Charles Cramer, the sum of one Dollar,

6th I give unto William Cramer, one Dollar,

7th I give unto my Daughter Sarah Cramer Twenty five acres of Land part of that Tract whereon Aaron Cramer lives to be sold off at the East of said Tract.

It is to remain with few words. During her life time also I give her my Pleasant land at that is it of also one father, &c. and furniture

8th I give unto my son Aaron Cramer the balance of that Tract of Land whereon Aaron now lives also the Tract of Land whereon I now live at the Death of my Wife also the land lying near at the Death of Sarah Cramer.

9th I allow Thomas Cramer my Executor to live with my Wife until I die I then give him one Horse
10th I allow Seth Cramer, my Grand Son to live with Mrs. Cramer until I die I then give him one Horse
11th at the Death of my Wife I give the whole of my unincumbered Estate to Sarah Cramer, Mary Schofield, and Elizabeth Krapp to be equally divided.

12th I create my Wife and my Son Aaron Cramer Executors of my last Will and

also I give her my Manufacture and that is

8th I give unto my Son Aaron Climer, the Balance
of that Tract of Land whereon Aaron now lives
also the Tract of Land whereon I now live at the
Death of my Wife also the lands very at the

with my Wife until Fred I then give him one Horse

10th I allow Seth Climer, my Grand Son to live with
my Wife until Fred I then give him one Horse

Schoolfield and Elizabeth Sniffed to be equally
