Do make & declare this my last Will & Testament, First I Give Bequeath my Wife Elizabeth that she shall have her living or a sufficient support & maintenance During her widowhood of the plantation on which I now live on with all the Wheat or Corn now growing on the Ground or in the Barn crib & elsewhere at my death together with all my Horres except one all my Cows Hoes & such all my household furniture except what will be mentioned to some of my Children) likewise utensils, tools Cook & Vessel & Wood also my Negro man ^{named} George & likewise if any money is left after the Negroes have got their part the remainder is to be my Wifes but her disposal. 2^d I Give my sons now married & my Daughters Land Each One Dollar. 3^d I Give my Daughters viz Hannah Nancy & Mary Each One, One Hundred Dollars. 4th I Give my Daughter Mary Connell Two Hundred Dollars & one Negro Girl named Ayles One bed & furniture One Boxall & one Case of Drawers & Book Case. 5th I Give my daughter Sarah Connell Six Hundred Dollars One bed & furniture. 6th I Give my Daughter Ruth Connell the land I bought of Daniel Shoemaker with 15 1/2 lots across the land I now live on likewise two Hundred Dollars and a Negro Girl named Charity the 15 poles I live on

In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Woodburn of the State of North Carolina County of Guilford being in a sound State of ~~health~~ body but of a perfect sound & disposing mind do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner of form as follows: 1st After the payment of all my said debts I Give & bequeath to my son John Woodburn One dollar as his full portion of my property. 2nd I Give & bequeath to the heirs of my son William Woodburn One dollar as their full portion. 3rd I Give & bequeath unto my son David Woodburn One Dollar as his full portion. 4th I Give & bequeath to the heirs of my son Arthur Woodburn One Dollar as their full portion. 5th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Wharton One dollar as her full portion. 6th I Give & bequeath to the heirs of my daughter Ann Cornett One Dollar as their full portion. 7th I Give & bequeath to the Children of my son Robert Woodburn the whole tract or parcel of land wherein I now live viz to Mary Woodburn Ann Woodburn Margera Woodburn Samuel Cockins Woodburn & Jesse Dickins Woodburn to be divided amongst them share & share alike & my son Robert Woodburn to have his living off it his life time from rent, also my whole set of Smiths tools I Give & bequeath to my Grand son Jesse Swain Woodburn & my son Robert to have the use of them to work on his lifetime from rent, & the remaining part of my probate not before mentioned I leave to my son Robert's Children to be disposed of equally amongst them.

& Book Case One bed Furniture.

7th I Give my son Levi Donnell the plantation I now live on
and all the land I own adjoining it except the land I give
my Daughter Ruth) likewise I Give my son Levi my two
Waggon's all my Ploughs Hoes & Harrows my Dutch Sawd & Still
& Rifle Gun all my farming utensils One bed Furniture
One horse Saddle one Negro man named Bill also
my Smith tools & Grind Mill.

8th I allow my Books to be equally divided to all my
Children.

Lastly I Give my son James my Surveying Instruments
likewise I constitute my Wife Elizabeth & my son
James Donnell to be my Sole Executors of this my last
Will & Testament, & do hereby disannull all former Wills
or Testaments by me before this time or named, Confirming
this to be my last Will & Testament in Witness hereunto I have
set my hand & seal the day & year above written
