In the Name of God Amen, I John Ford one of the County & State
above mentioned, being of sound Mind & Memory but frail & Weak in body
Calling to mind the Mortality of the body & knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die, do make & Ordain this my last & Last Will
& Testament in the Manner & form following.

First & principally of all I recommend my Soul to God who gave it, & my

I shall receive the same by the Almighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate which it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I will & divide in the following manner - 1st I will that all my Just Ditts be paid

2nd I will & devise unto my son Daniel, One Hundred Acres of land, on the North end of my tract, from which said Hundred Acres my beloved wife is to be maintained during her Natural life or as long as she is my Widow. - I will that he (Daniel) pay Ten Dollars for the above land to my Daughters. - The balance of my land I will & bequeath unto my son Leonard for which he is to pay Twenty Dollars to my Daughters.

3rd I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Peggy during her Natural life or as long as she is my Widow. All such household furniture as she wished to keep, One Horse, One Cow, two Hogs, After her death (my wife) the above mentioned furniture, horse, cow, & hogs, are to be divided among my Daughters. - The balance of my property to be equally divided among my daughters.

And I hereby constitute, Ordain & appoint my true & trusty friends Henry Clapp & Daniel Faust Executors of this my Last Will & Testament, the Testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 10th day of March 1834.
