First I Give unto my son Moses Gilchrist all my Land & Plantation & every thing thereon including all the stock of every kind whatever that may belong to me or any thing what ever excepting only the ^{following} small Legacies.

Secondly I Give unto my son William Gilchrist One Dollar.

Thirdly I Give unto my daughter Margaret, W. Gibbons Twenty five Dollars which has been due to her for some time & to her & to her Daughter Martha & my Grand Daughter The bed which was allowed to her by her Aunt Martha dec'd.

Fourthly I Give unto my Grandson John Gilchrist Samuels Son my Rifle Gun.

Fifthly I Give unto John Gilchrist Son of Robert Gilchrist my Grand son the bed on which I lodge at night.

Sixthly & lastly I Give unto my three Grandsons John W. Gibbons Davidson Gilchrist & James Gilchrist whatever monies I may have at my decease or book debts.

I do appoint ^{for my Executors} my two Sons Robert Gilchrist & Moses Gilchrist.
