I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Ann McLogan my Negro woman Harriet & one Negro child her name is Barbara all my house hold & kitchen furniture that is all the using things therein also all my Stock of

Woods, hogs & sheep also my one Horse wagon & of each all my farming
tools & provisions on Woods free and clear of all incumbrances. During the term
of her married life & after the decease or death of my wife Mary Ann I
give & Bequeath to my daughter Dorothea & Elizabeth each twenty acres
of Land where upon I now live including my Mansion house and other out-houses
to be laid off so as to contain some two hundred acres, each of them to be equal them
to them their heirs & assigns for ever I also give & bequeath to said Dorothea
and Elizabeth each one little negro boy named Pottery each equal to them their
heirs or assigns the balance of my estate shall be sold by my Executors & out
of the proceeds of said sale I give to my son Timothy Ten, fifty dollars, when
his heirs and assigns.

Now I give to my daughter Lydia Twenty the sum of Twenty dollars also I give
I bequeath to my daughter Malberry each Twenty dollars, I give and bequeath
to my daughter Peggy each Twenty dollars - Then my will and
desire is that all the residue of my estate (if any) after taking away the debts
& Legacies above shall be equally divided between my seven children -
Timothy, Elizabeth, Lydia, Malberry, Peggy, Dorothea, & Elizabeth so as to
