following to be my last will and testament touching all
other businesses whatsoever in manner and form
God who first gave it and my body to be buried at
the discretion of my executors and my last will
to be paid them and I give and bequeath to my son
Reuben Land one lot and furniture consisting of two
chairs two counterpane two covered and quilt two
pillows and 3. I give and bequeath to my daughter
Carry Land one hundred acres of land whereon my
Cedley House now stands and all I give and bequeath
to my daughter Esther Land and all I give and bequeath
to my son and fifty acres of land a bequethly divided
between them and known by the name of the section tract
then set I give and bequeath to my son and his heirs and
to his wife during her life and three years from her
death of land whereon they now live by Eighty seven
acres being that more or less I give and bequeath
to my Granddaughter the Holder one greater part
that which I now have then 70 I give and bequeath
to my Granddaughter Mary Holder and her heirs and
all our heirs the youngest of old known to be known
that I have and I give and bequeath to my son and all
and all the kitchen furniture that I have and all
the black and wood and not made up to my then

Land Linn. Esther Lane and Stanley Lane and all the
 residue of my property together with one tract of Land
 Containing about sixty three acres or there abouts that being
 adjoin. Linn. Tom Linn on the one and Eliza Deane to be
 sold and the proceeds thereof after my last Debt paid
 upman is payed to be equally divided between my children
 all born. Reuben Lane Linn Lane Esther Lane and Stanley
