First I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Martha all my personal Estate excepting her Trunk & Furniture and two Winter Coats which I do give & bequeath to my two Daughters Anna and Mary each a Lin and a Kid, - And at the suggestion of her wisheth that the property which I have in such the lot as may be on hand be equally divided between my two Daughters Anna & Mary - And it is further my Will that my Wife Martha, shall keep the house & home where I now live, and have her Maintenance from the Plantation which I now occupy during her widowhood, and that my Father & Mother Mary, Anne & Sarah Mendenhall have a home on the Farm and have their Maintenance from the Proceeds of the farm by me provided - As much to a total amount between myself & my Father above named to and in consideration of his interest in me to and of consequence the sole right and title of the Land & premises whereon I now live to have to hold the same for and in consideration of and to his wife Sarah, being in fact supported by me during their lives at law
And I will & bequeath to my son Samuel all my Land & Tenements with the Reversion that he will & truly fulfill my Will as to the Maintenance & Accommodation of my Wife Martha & my Father & Mother above named
