What it sells for it is my will that my Grand daughter Jane
Harris have when of Age or at her marriage - it is also my
Will that my Son Aaron have the Sword & Tonge.
Item I Give & bequeath unto my Grandson John Harris the Other
Third of my movable Property & that all to be Sold & divided as is
above directed. Item I Give to my Daughter Hannah Mills
Ten Shillings. - I also give my Grand Daughter Jane Hodson
Ten Shillings. - And Lastly I Appoint Constitute & Establish
my Friend Balthazar Coffin Executor to this my last will and
Testament Proving & Recording all other Wills hitherto
made by me in witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand & profixed my seal this 12th day of the 10th mo 1818
