Clover Cards One German Prayer Book from Bushels of  
Wheat eight Bushels of Corn One barrel of Corn first choice  
of Two Cows & half a Barn to feed the Cows during the  
present winter Two Hogs first choice One Sheep One  
Cooking Pot One smoothing iron Half of the dried fruit  
all the soap One Earthen dish One Basin three Spoons  
One candle half of the linens & further the half of all the Cotton  
the half of all the flax all the skin garment thread

half of the house on the side of the street & the  
 left portion -  
 2<sup>o</sup> to settle what sum should be due me one third of the mon-  
 thly rent for my board while one third of the same -  
 to be given to you before we are the payment to be sent after  
 3<sup>o</sup> to pay all the expenses incurred by me in  
 date and the manager is to be responsible -  
 4<sup>o</sup> except that above mentioned -  
 5<sup>o</sup> to settle all expenses to him and myself among us the  
 who will be charged against me -  
 6<sup>o</sup> to make out my hand and seal the copy and then countersign  
 written and signed Plaintiff and defendant  
 in presence of me
