

The Last Will and Testament of John Schofield of
Northampton, Suffolk County

I John Schofield considering the uncertainty of this
mortal life, and being of Sound mind and memory do give
be the Almighty God for the same. do make and publish this
my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following
(That is to say—)

Item 1st. After all my lawful debts are paid, I give and bequeath
unto my beloved Wife Mary Schofield, All the money
on hand or due to my Estate. Together with the following
Articles. Viz. One bed and furniture, one side saddle
one wheel, my cupboard, Bureau, & Clock, during her
widowhood, or during her life, if living single,
and then to her two daughters Angelitta and
Mary R. Schofield.

Item 2d I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsey A. Dimes twenty five
five cents

Item 3d I give and bequeath to my three Sons Joseph, William,
and Benjamin, each of them, the sum of \$1000

- Item 3 I give and bequeath to my three sons Joseph William
and Benken E. Schoofield each of them twenty five cents
- Item 4 I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Schoofield one
bed and furniture one wheel one side saddle
- Item 5 I give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Schoofield the
addition of furniture which she has made to the bed
which her Grandmother gave her
- Item 6 I give and bequeath to my son Daniel D. Schoofield the
three childrens black mare named Silver and saddle
one bed & furniture one plough one axe and the
land which I purchased of Joseph Brawley being west
of the branch named Meadows Run
- Item 7 I give and bequeath to my son Samuel S. Schoofield
Ten Dollars
- Item 8 I give and bequeath to my daughter Angeltta Schoofield
one bed and furniture one side saddle one wheel
- Item 9 I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary B Schoofield one
bed and furniture one side saddle one wheel

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Item 10th The Remainder of my estate Land and other property I leave as follows. To my wife Mary Schofield. and four Daughters namely Sarah Sarah Angelina and Mary D. Schofield each holding an equal Part whilst living. But if either dead or married, then the Parts shall return to the Surviving Remainder until the last one is either dead or married. and then the Land to be sold and equally divided among all the Surviving heirs what other property they may possess. Shall be equally divided amongst the Survivors of the last married four Daughters

Item 11th I hereby Appoint sole Executors of this my last will and Hook M. Elmer and Daniel G. Schofield.
