I John Walker of the County of Guilford & State of North Carolina: being weak in body, but of sound judgment and perfect understanding knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do ordain this my last Will & Testament. First of all I do Well & Ordain my body to be decently buried, and as touching my worldly estate which God has given me. I do will & Ordain in the following manner, I do will all my Just & lawfull debts to be paid. I do will to my son Levin Walker Two thirds. I do Will to my Grand son son of John Walker One Third. I do appoint Levin Walker whole & sole Executor to see that that this my last Will be executed according to its true Intent & meaning Signed Sealed & delivered this 10th day of September 1822
