

In the Name of God Amen. I John Walker of the
County of Guilford & State of North Carolina: being
weak in body, but of sound judgment and perfect
understanding knowing that I am appointed for all
men once to die, do ordain this my last will &
testament. First of all I do will & ordain my body
to be decently buried, and as touching my worldly estate
which God has given me... I do will & ordain in the
following manner, I do will all my just & lawful debts
to be paid. I do will to my son Luman Walker two
thirds. I do will to my Grand son son of John
Walker One Third. I do appoint Luman Walker whole
& sole Executor to see that that this my last will
be executed according to its true intent & meaning
Signed sealed & delivered this 10th day of September
1822.
