Item 2nd I give to my beloved wife Annaridg Work One corner House, and One corner Barn, Saddle and bridle, Two first Choice Cows & Calves, one half the flock of Sheep, Ten first Choice of Hogs, Two Beds & furniture, all the Household & Kitchen furniture and Loom, Two first Choice Hens & geese, One Ox, One Mule, One cow, Ten first Choice of Shoats Forty barrels of Corn, One fodder house, six blade stacks, all the Wheat on hand, all the Oats, Cotton, flax, and Wool, Two hammers, all the Land I possess Two Chests, all the Nails I have on hand to cover her house, & things her for and during her natural life.

Item 3rd I give to my Nephew James Hylleton & his heirs forever One horse by the name of Buck, One Saddle, One Ox, One Mule, One cow, One plow, One hammer, One pair of geese Twenty Barrels Corn.

Item 4th I give to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Sumner One Dollar.

Item 5th I give to my beloved Daughter Elenor Mayson One Dollar.

Item 6th All the property not set apart to any person (I may die possessed or) to be sold to the highest bidder and should this exceed the debts the overplus to go to my wife Annaridg Work, to be governed in this.
