

I Jonathan Anthony of the County of Guilford and State of North Carolina being of Sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit: I give first that my executors (hereinafter named) shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the rank of my relations or friends and pay all Funeral Expenses together with all my last debts.

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Maclen the sum of ten Dollars it being her proportionable part with what she has already had
 I Give to my daughter Phoebe Anthony a good and comfortable support and maintenance out of my estate as long as she remains in her present debility that is to say Invalidity. She should become of Sound mind again and natural when she then shall have no equal share or part with my three sons.

I Give and bequeath to all the remainder part of my estate it may to my three sons James, James or Chas. Anthony to be equally divided between them with what they have each one already had or separately received.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my two sons James & Chas. Anthony my lawful executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same and every

to put execution to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will
and testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same and my
last clause thereof being touching and declaring, utterly void all other
testaments by me heretofore made in witness whereof I the said
