Item To my well beloved daughter Elizabeth Edwards I give & devise One feather bed & furniture.

Item To my well beloved daughter Feltz Anna I give and devise Five C. cloths.

Item To my well beloved daughter Feltz Anna I give & devise One feather bed & furniture and my largest iron pot

Item To my well beloved son Hannah Edwards and to each or more beloved Daughters Rachel Elvade Martha Russell & Hannah each I give One Cotton sack

Item To my well beloved son John Edwards his heirs & assigns I give & devise all the tract of Land (not otherwise disposed of) wherein I reside, supposed to contain about Three hundred & fifty Acres be the same now or here and also every Other Article & thing to me belonging or in any wise appertaining whatsoever to be found, which have not been otherwise bequeathed by this Will etc

Lastly I constitute and appoint my son John Edwards my whole & sole Executor of this Will & Testament

In Witness of all and each of the things herein contained I have set my hand & seal this 29th day of May 1826.
