of my Executors hereafter named, And touching the disposal of all such  
temporal estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me I give & bequeath  
dispose of as follows

being the tract of land I now live on, together with one Corral Man,  
Also all the household furniture, likewise all my stock of Cattle, & hogs all  
my stock of Sheep also all my working tools.

dispose of my present Crop, I likewise give that to my son, also.

I give to my beloved son Joshua Martin or his heirs One Dollar & twenty  
five Cents which is to be raised out of my Estate. I also Give to my son  
Joshua Martin One Dollar & twenty five Cents.

And I do hereby constitute & appoint my beloved son Ezekiel Mitty Martin  
to be my sole Executor and no other of this my last Will & Testament And  
I do hereby revoke disannul & make void, all former Wills & Testaments  
by me heretofore made in Whichever of the said Joshua Martin to  
this my last Will & Testament do set my hand and seal this Twenty first  
day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred  
& Twenty four.

1<sup>st</sup> I will & bequeath to my beloved son Fendly Shaw. One Cow & One Large bible,

2<sup>nd</sup> I will & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Jane Hamilton One Bed & furniture, One spinning wheel One Coat, & all my Clothing that is household.

3 I will & bequeath to my beloved son Joseph Shaw all the plow farming Utensils &c. One Wheel Barrow, all the Hogs, my Chest & Table One black Mare, & the Cote Called Dick, One bed & furniture, by him paying the Debt that I am in,

4<sup>th</sup> I will & bequeath to my beloved son William Shaw the Wagon jointly with his brother Joseph, that is one half to each.

5<sup>th</sup> I will & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Margaret Shaw one Cupboard by her paying her Sister Ann four Dollars

6<sup>th</sup> I will & bequeath to my beloved Daughters Margaret Shaw & Ann Shaw all the Household & Kitchen Furniture, all the Cotton & flax all the Sheep Equally between them.

7<sup>th</sup> I Constitute Appoint & Ordain my beloved son Fendly Shaw the
