Item I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Whittington One Dollar to my forward daughter Elizabeth Gypsum One Dollar and to my son Ezekiel Whittington One Dollar, and to my daughter Mary Gullett One Dollar, & to my son Nehemiah Whittington One Dollar. And my daughter Nancy Purdee One Dollar, and to my daughter Sarah Ireland Ten Dollars. And to my daughter Sealey Andrew One Dollar.

Item. And all the remainder of my estate I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy Whittington and her seven children to be equally divided. and I do constitute & appoint my beloved wife Nancy Whittington & my son Thomas Whittington my sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament And I do utterly deny all other Wills or Testaments or Writings to the same.
