In the Name of God Amen this fifth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred & Twenty Nine, I Latham Donnell of the County of Guilford and State of N. Carolina being weak in body but of sound Mind & Memory Calling to mind the Mortality of my body Do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament and as for such worldly property as it has pleased God to bless me with I Give and bequeath the same as followeth to-wit:

First I Give unto my Wife Charlotte Donnell one Negro boy Named Charles. Also two Beds & furniture. Also all my Household furniture (except the Case of Drawers, and Book Case, Clock & Case, & the fat,) and all the kitchen furniture used up & about the house, Also all her Cans & spinning wheels, also two horses & also her choice, also eight head of Cattle, all my hogs, & sheep & all the grain and forage of every description, Also I Give unto my Wife Charlotte Donnell during her widowhood the free use of the plantation & also the use of my Negro Calib since and all his children, also the use of Smith during her widowhood also I give to my wife Charlotte her bridle and saddle.

Item I Give to my step Daughter Martha Donnell one Bed & furniture. Item I Give to my son and bequeath unto Latham Donnell son of Edwin Donnell at the termination of my wife's widowhood, all my Land & Buildings that lies west of the Big Branch that runs through the plantation - also my Negro Man Named Smith also my Negro woman Named since & her children Named all being Milton Biddy & Amanda - with all her increase hereafter. Also I Give to said Latham my bay horse, and two Beds & furniture. Also my Wagon & gear & farming tools, and the Beef fat & half of my Pork. If said Latham Donnell should die without any legitimate Children of his own to have his property then I allow & Ordain that all the property both real & personal that I wished to him, to be given to the Children of my step Daughter Martha William Donnell's wife, to be divided.

among them as their parents may see fit
I give & bequeath to Nathan Donnell son of William & Martha all my
land & premises lying east of the Big Branch that runs through the plantation
I give to Charlotte Donnell daughter of William & Martha my care of
Drawers & Book Cases reserving the use thereof to her Grandmother during her life.
I give unto Joseph Donnell son of William & Martha my Clock & Case and
the half of my books. I give unto William Donnell son of Brother John
my Negro Man named Bert also my Negro Man named Caleb reserving the
use of Caleb to my wife during her widowhood. I give to my brother
Andrew Donnell One Dollar. I give to my brother Thomas Donnell
One Dollar. I give to my George Donnell One Dollar. I give to
the heirs of Brother James Donnell One Dollar. I give to the heirs
of Brother John Donnell One Dollar. I give to the heirs of Brother
Donnell One Dollar. I give to the heirs of Sister Hannah Denny
One Dollar. I give to the heirs of Sister Jane Donnell One Dollar. Also I
allow all my just debts to be paid. Also all the remainder of my Notes
Money, and all the remainder of my property of every description not men-
tioned before in this my last Will & Testament I leave to be equally
divided between my Wife Charlotte, and Nathan Donnell son of Edwin
and William Donnell son of Brother John.

And Further I do Constitute and Appoint William Donnell son of Brother
John sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament. Revoking all others.
Wills & Testaments by me formerly made & I do Ordain that & only this to be my
last Will & Testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
