

In the name of God amen - This fourth day of March 1810 - I Levi Tucker of Guilford County & State of N. Carolina being of sound mind & memory do hereby be to God & calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament in the first place I recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent & Christianlike manner at the expense of my Executors hereafter named.

Item - I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Peggy Tucker my father bed two cows & eight head of hogs, her riding saddle and one large beast and two sheep all of her own choosing from my estate & plantation whereon I now live as long as she remains a widow that is to say until the death of the Haylettsville road & after her death the land is to go to my son Gadsden Tucker.

Item - I give & bequeath to my son Gadsden Tucker my still house & all my stills and all the utensils therunto belonging also my wheat fan, & it to remain in the barn where it stands for the use of his mother & while remains in possession of said land - I also give my house clock to my son Gadsden after his mother's death or marriage.

Item - I give and bequeath to my son Anderson Tucker that tract of land of one hundred & fifty acres more or less on which he now lives.

Item - I give to my son John Tucker that tract he now has in possession called the Kelley tract containing two hundred acres as long as he pays his sister Mary Tucker one hundred dollars & interest from the year 1818 to her in full possession but if my said son John Tucker die

Item - I give and bequeath to my son Anderson Tucker that

soon as he pays his sister Mary Tucker one hundred dollars & interest from
January 1818 to be in full possession but if my said son John Tucker die
before he has any children by lawful marriage then said land to be sold &
price equally divided between his sisters.

Item - I give and bequeath to my son Abbit Tucker all the land
possep north of the Fayetteville road & north east till it comes to the origi-
nal corner, once belonging to Andrew Gamble & then to run a S.E. course
till it strikes Frederick Spies line & this to be a division line between
Carlos & Abbit Tucker, I also give my son Abbit Tucker my silver watch and
have the whole and sole benefit and possession thereof after my death.

Item - I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy wife of Charles Cansey
to be paid to her one year after my decease out of my estate one hundred dollars.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary one feather bed & furniture one cow and calf & a horse beast worth fifty dollars & her saddle & and one hundred dollars in cash to be paid out of my estate one year after my decease.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Diana one good feather bed & furniture, one horse & saddle one cow and calf & two hundred dollars out of my estate to be paid one year after my decease.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Leah Tucker one good feather bed and furniture one cow & calf and two hundred and fifty dollars and the interest of sd two hundred & fifty dollars from one year after my decease untill she arrives at the age of eighteen.

Item I also give and bequeath to my two youngest daughters Tucker Elizabeth Tucker three hundred dollars each & the interest of it from the time they arrive to the age of ten years untill eighteen years and their money to be raised out of my land in the Western Country & that land to be sold in the year eighteen hundred & twenty after all expenses are paid & sd money raised if any thing remains of the price I wish it to be equally divided among my three youngest children, and all my other property if any remains I wish to remain in the hands of my Executors untill the death or marriage of my wife Peggy Tucker and then to be sold and equally divided between all my daughters and my son Abbit, except thirty acres of land lying in the N.E. of the land on which Audertou Tucker lives, which land was entered by John Lee which land I give and bequeath to Audertou Tucker's daughter Betty and to remain in the hands of Audertou Tucker untill she arrives to the age of 18.
