and at her death my will is that Sam'l my
negro man go then to my beloved brother
Stephen E Cunningham my will is at my said
mother's death my negro boy Benjamin go
then to my beloved sister Jane Roberts and the
rest of her body I give and bequeath to my
friend Maggie Sarah Cunningham my bed
and furniture and all my house hold under
Kitchen furniture with all my farming tools
and all my stocks of live stock
