by Christian Gold the foregoing is to be divided among
my children also all my property whether
Real or personal I want all equally divided

Samuel and Benjamin during her natural life
and at her death my will is that Samuel my
negro man go then to my beloved brother -
James C Cunningham my will is at my said
Mother's death my negro boy Benjamin go
then to my beloved sister Jane Roberts and the
use of her body I give and bequeath to my
beloved Sister Mannah Cunningham my bed
and furniture and all my household and
kitchen furniture with all my farming tools
and all my Stock of horses and cattle
