make Constitute & Ordain this my Last will & Testament (Viz.)
First & principally I Recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God
who gave it & my Body to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian
Burial at the discretion of my Executors herein After Appointed.
And as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to Bless me
with in this life I Give demise and dispose of in the following manner

Barrow the Sum of ten shillings to be Paid out of my Estate
And my four Negroes Viz. Chaney a Negro Woman and Three of her Children

and Mary Noblin, the Children of my well beloved Grand son Christopher
Noblin & Litcha his wife to be equally Divided among them at or after
the decease of their father Christopher Noblin but my Will & meaning
is that the Above named Negroes be Paid out by my Executors during
the natural Life of my Grand son Christopher Noblin & there to pay
to be paid or Distributed to Said Christopher Noblin & his family
at the Direction of my Executors during his Natural Life & in case
there should be any part of the Wages for which the above named
Negroes shall be Paid left in the hands of my Executors at or after
