make Constitute & Ordain this my Last will & Testament as follows:

First & principally I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God
who gave it & my Body to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian
Burial at the discretion of my Executors herein after Appointed.

And as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow
with in this life I give dispose and dispose of in the following manner

Hoblin & Sibba his wife to be equally Divided among them at or after
the decease of their Father Christopher Hoblin but my Will & meaning

the natural Life of my Grand son Christopher Hoblin & his wages
to be Paid or Distributed to said Christopher Hoblin & his family
at the Discretion of my Executors during his natural Life & in case
there Should be any part of the wages for which the above named
Negroes Shall be Kept left in the Hands of my Executors above after
the decease of my Grand son Christopher Hoblin my wife shall receive
