Now I Give & bequeath my land one hundred & thirty six acres after the death or intermarriage of my above named wife Margerut Jester, to my Three sons namely John Jester William Jester & Markil Jester to be equally divided between the three to them & their heirs forever.

Now I Give & bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Jester One feather bed & furniture One cow & calf as her part of my estate.

& their heirs forever.

Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Lister One feather bed of furniture
& one cow & calf as her part of my estate.

Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Margaret Lister One feather
bed & furniture, & one Cow & calf as her part of my Estate.

Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Phoebe Lister One feather bed
& furniture & one Cow & calf as her part of my Estate.

Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Lister the sum of Ten Shillings
besides what she has already had as her part of my Estate.

Item My will & desire is that the remainder of my Estate after
the death or intermarriage of my above named wife Margaret
Lister should be sold & equally divided among my Six
Children hereafter named Rebecca Lister John Lister
Margaret Lister William Lister Markil Lister & Phoebe
Lister.

And Lastly I do Constitute & appoint my Wives Margaret Lister &
Richard Allendinham Whole Sole Executors to this my Last

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Will & Testament Ratifying this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament
In Writings whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Second
Day of January In the year of Our Lord 1822
