Katherine Margaret Effy Elizabeth & Rebecca.

Fourth I make bequests unto my daughter Mary Maydon Bradford
Fifth I make bequests unto my daughter Mary Morris. Our
daughter has given me down upon my marriage —

Sixth It is my will that all the balance of my property that
is not immediately necessary for the use of my family
be sold & the proceeds thereof after paying all my debts
held by me or my executors be equally divided among my
children namely Elizabeth Katherine Margaret Effy
Elizabeth & Rebecca who shall be their as my executors
aforesaid.

Seventh I make bequests unto my daughter Sally Morris fifty four
Pounds I make bequests unto my daughter Anne Maydon 50⁰⁰
and thirty marks and sixteen pence being part of my
widow mite and certain my heirlooms given to her by her
husband John Knight.

Divided among my children namely Charles Henry
Katharine Margaret Effy Elizabeth & Rebecca.

Fourth I make bequests unto my daughter Henry Margarette Cook.
Fifth I make bequests unto my daughter Mary Morris. One
Feather bed upon the down of my marriage mattress.

Sixth It is my will that all the balance of my property that
is not immediately necessary for the use of the family
be sold at the proceeds thereof after my decease to my sons
Charles & Mary my expenses to be equally divided among my
children namely Charles Henry Katharine Margaret Effy
Elizabeth & Rebecca who shall receive the same as my executors
equally.
