Item I Give & bequeath to my Son William Widdofe Ten Shillings for his Legacy of my Estate.

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son Charles Widdofe all my Tract of Land Stock and all my Other Property by his finding my Wife Winny Widdofe a Comfortable Support during her widowhood and also finding my daughter Polly Widdofe a Good & sufficient Support during her life my Will is if my son Charles should fail & Refuse to find my Wife & daughter Polly a sufficient Support that my Executors should Rack out my Lands or as much of them as will Bring a Support for my Wife and daughter during the Above mentioned Time my Will is that my Wife have in Care of my Lands & Other Property until my son Charles Arrives to the Age of Twenty One & then my Will is that my son Charles take in Charge of my Land & Farming Tools & that my Wife shall have in Care of my Stock & household Goods during her widowhood. She not dispose of nor Sell Except for a Support for herself and daughter Polly my Will is that my daughter Betsey Connor have four Acres of Land on the South East Corner during her widowhood to build a house & Clear One Acre of Ground. My Will is that my daughter Peggy have a Good Bed Tick & Twenty Pounds of Pewter.

Lastly I nominate & Appoint my Trusty Friend Athamar Hunt, Executor of this my Last Will & Testament. Witness my hand

Support during her life my will is if my Son Charles should

fail & Refuse to find my Wife & daughter Polly a sufficient  
Support that my Executor should Raise out my Lands or as

Much of them as will Bring a Support for my Wife and  
daughter during the Above mentioned Time my Will is that my

Wife have in Care of my Lands & Other Property until my Son  
Charles Arrives to the Age of Twenty One & then my Will is that my

Son Charles take in Charge if of my Land & Farming Tools &

In the Name of God am I Thomas Dick of the County of  
Guilford and State of North Carolina being of a Sound and perfect  
Mind and Memory (blessed be God) do this Twelfth day of December  
in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty  
Make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in manner  
following that is to say First I Give and bequeath unto my son John  
W. Dick the plantation Whence I live in our County near One  
thousand acres of Land Mills and all that appertains thereto.  
I Give him also my Negro man Jim and I Give my son John W.  
Dick to take possession of all my Credits and of my Show and pay  
my Debts out of them and of any thing left here it is to be  
be divided amongst my three I do Give my son John W. Dick  
Gods Horse saddle and Bridle one Bed and Furniture and one half  
of my Libra of Books. Secondly I do Give and bequeath unto my  
Daughter Elizabeth W. Dick my Negro Girl Lucy and her increase  
one good horse bridle & saddle and two good Beds Furniture  
and I Give her also one good Table & one Brazen Shovel I do
