 in the hands of William Henry and if there be any
 left at my decease it is to be paid over to my son Larry
 Frager and lastly I conclude and appoint my son
 Larry Frager Executor of this my last will and testa-
 ment and this only to be my last will and testa-
 ment I witness whereof I have signed at my
 hand and seal the fourteenth day of the Eleventh
 month in the year of our Lord One thousand
 Eight hundred and Twenty five
