to Margurat Stewart, One Bed with all the furniture thereunto belong
Also One third of all my Dresser Table & Kitchen Furniture also all my
Wearing Apparel of Every Kind, I Give & bequeath to Adam
Lachey Stewart, One Bed & Furniture also at my death if I shall be in
possession of a horse or mare that to be Adam Lachey Stewart but if there
should be neither of Either Kind the Sum of Sixty Dollars in money
Also his Uncles Walnut Chest Also One Cow one 2 Year Old Steer & One
Year Old - I Give to Adam Lachey Stewart, One third part
of all my Kitchen Dresser & Furniture - I Give to Adam
Lachey Stewart, One negro Girl Named Ginegi Aged Sixteen
Years With all her Issue and all my Books to be Equally Divided
Between Walter McConnell Margurat Stewart & Adam Lachey Stewart
I Give & bequeath to Joseph Stewart, One Two Year Old Heifer

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I am I give & bequeath to Martha Stewart One Three Year Old Cow
& her calf I am I give to Ruane Stewart my Large Walnut Chest
I am I bequeath to Martha Simons Wife to John Simons Twenty
Dollars I am I give & bequeath to Martha Lacking M'Bride Daughter
to Samuel M'Bride the Sum of Twenty Dollars Now Both Living
in the State of Tennessee - And After Necessary Arrangements made

McConnell my Executors of this my Will & Testament and I do
