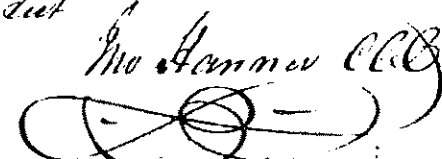

 Testament and I do hereby revoke all and every other former Wills &
 Testaments Ratifying and publishing this to be my last will &
