Thirdly I allow the remaining part of my Money to be equally divided
betwixt my two Sisters Elizabeth Byrwell & Susanna Byrwell.
And I also do appoint for my Executors Martin Knight & Williams
this Twelfth day of February in the year of our Lord
One Thousand Eight hundred & Twenty Eight
