Item 4th I give unto my Brother Hugh Pendray Sr Barrell of corn that is now on hand

Item 5th My daughter Sarah I give and bequeath one Horse all of the aforesaid Horses Bridles Saddles
to be of equal value

Item 6th My will is after all the aforesaid bequests are paid the balance of my property to be
equally divided between my 5 children

Item 7 My will & wish is that my son John C Campbell act as my executor herein under
my hand & seal this 21 February A.D. 1841
