I Mary Hussey Widow of the County Guilford State of North Carolina being of sound Mind and disposing memory do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following —
My Will is that all my Just Ditts & personal Charges be paid
Then I Give and bequeath unto my three Grandsons namely Jonathan Henry & Joseph (Sons of my beloved Son Saml Hussey deceased) Five Hundred Dollars to Each of them Which said several Legacies or sums of money I Will & Order to be paid to the said Respective Legatee when they arrive at the age of Twenty One years Old and it is my Will & meaning that if Either of my Above said Grandsons or any of them should die in minority or Without heirs of body that the Surviving brother or brothers shall have those Legacy or legacies I do devise to them & their heirs forever I bequeath the Above mentioned Legacies to my three Above named Grandsons in place of Land property —
It is the part of Land that my Son Thomas Hussey have had paid off & he formerly Occupied I have conveyed away & he has received a full & ward for the Same in Order to clear the said Thomas Hussey of his Just Ditts
Then I Give & bequeath unto my three Above said Grandsons Jonathan Henry & Joseph Each an Iron pot my Largest pot to Jonathan my next largest to Henry & my next Largest to Joseph to them & their heirs forever
Then I Give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary Hunt One spinning Wheel & One three Quart basin to her & her heirs forever
Then I Give & bequeath unto my Son Stephen Hussey my bed & Furniture & my bedstead One set of Spools One Hackle & my Laze One pair of Shears

And my largest square Oak & One Gallon Bason Lin Sharp
One Cow & Calf & Three deep Rustle plates I give them to him & his
heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Coffin One square bason
One square Oak & Three square plates to her & heirs forever

Item I give unto my Son Ebediah Hussey five shillings to him & his heirs forever

Item I Give unto my Grand Daughter Angelina Ball five shillings to her & her
heirs forever

Item I Give unto my Grand Children Elya Hoke & John Hussey (Daughter
& Son of Joseph Hussey Grand of Rowan County, each five
shillings to them & their heirs forever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my four Daughters, namely Sarah Lydia
Rebekah & Ann all my wearing clothes to be equally divided ^{amongst} them
part & part alike to them & their heirs forever.

Item It is my will that all the residue of my estate whatever not herein
before otherwise effectually disposed of (after payment of my
debts, legacy & funeral Charges) I do bequeath unto my two
Sons namely Thomas & Stephen to be equally divided
between them part & part alike to them & their heirs
forever.

Lastly I do make Ordain & constitute my beloved sons Thomas
& Stephen Hussey Joint Executors of this my last will
& Testament I do hereby utterly disavow revoke &
annul all & every other former Testament will legacy or
Executors by me heretofore named ratifying & confirming this
