I will that the Eighty Acres of Land I own adjoining
the lands of William Walker John Brightfield & others
be sold and the monies arising from the sale of
the same be applied in paying all my just debts
and the remainder of money if any from said
Sale after paying my just debts as aforesaid I will
give unto my said Grand Son Gran Magee. I further
will and give unto my said Grandson Gran Magee One
Horse Bridle and Saddle which said Horse Bridle
and Saddle is Known by the name of the Said Gran
Magee. I also will and give unto my said Grandson
Gran Magee One Bed & furniture and Large Walnut
Chest which which said Bed & Chest is now in the
House of Rubin Lundy who married my Daughter
Priscilla. I further will and give unto my said Grandson
Gran Magee One Rife Gun. I will and bequeath unto
my daughter Priscilla Land Ten Dollars I will &
give unto Narsessa Land Three Cotton Frocks Two
Collin Petticoats & One Yar Sill to the remainder of
my weaing apparel I will and give unto my Daughter
Priscilla Land. I will and give unto my Grand
Daughter Lucy & Daugherty my Side Saddle and
bed & furniture I further will and give unto my Said
Grandson Gran Magee One Bed & furniture & one large
Walnut Chest which is now in the House of my Son
in Law Rubin Land which married my Daughter

My Womans apparel I will and give unto my Daughter
Priscilla Land. I will and give unto my Grand
Daughter Lucy & Daugherty my Side Saddle and
bed & furniture I further will and give unto my said
Grandson Gran Magee. One Bed & furniture & one large
Walnut Chest which is now in the House of my Son
in law Ruben Land which married my Daughter
