State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory do hereby declare
the same, do this twenty sixth day of March in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety do make ordain and publish
this my last will and testament in manner and form following that
to say

First of all I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife
Mary the one third of all my estate both personal and real and she
at her death is to leave all her said third part to the children to be
divided among them equally.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary twelve hundred
money and one cow

4 I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Estlin Jean
Margaret Sophiah Reachel each twelve pounds in money and one cow

5 I give and bequeath to my son John all my plantation and
if it should or does be a boy that my wife now is big with when it is born
I order and allow him and John to have the land equally divided between
them and if it should be a girl she is to have a share equal to the rest
above - Also my will and pleasure is that if any of above named children
should die in their young age I order and allow the part of such child
either under age or before marriage to be equally divided among all the rest

6 I order and allow all my lawfull and just debts to be
paid out of my estate before any of the above divisions are made.

7 And my body at my decease I order and desire it shall be
buried in Christian and decent manner not doubting but I shall rise
like the same again at the resurrection by the mighty power of God.

8 I hereby constitute make and ordain my wife Mary Estlin
of this my last will and testament - revoking disannulling all former
wills legacies bequeathments and testaments of whatever kind made in
my name or for me - and do publish and pronounce this and so forth
to be my last will and testament - in the presence of us who were at
