2nd I will that my wife Molly shall have the use of all my household furniture and two Cows her Choice out of my stock and if said Cows die George shall find her two ~~Cows~~ Others if she wants them & I give to my wife my Ring Maria.

3rd I give to my Daughter Barbara Cobb my Colt two years Old
Next Spring

4th I will that a tract of Land that I bought of Thomas Buckham Called One hundred & twenty Acres Adjoining the Land that we live on and all the rest of Movable Property be sold at public sale and if my wife thinks proper to give up any of the Articles willed to her them to be sold also. - I will that all the Money Arising from said sale and Dues due me be equally divided amongst all my Daughters the Children of my daughter Molly Cobb shall have their Mothers share that is her equal share with the rest of my Daughters to be equally divided among all her Children.

I will that my wife shall have the Money life or hand but if she thinks proper to give it up at any time it shall be equally Divided amongst all my Daughters my Daughter Molly Cobb Children having their part as aforesaid.

After the death of my wife I will that all the household furniture and all other Movable that I have be sold at public sale

of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred & Twenty Six Make and publish this
my last Will & Testament in manner following, viz. First I give and bequeath

Called One hundred & twenty Acres Adjoining the Land that we live
on and all the rest of Movable property he sold at public sale and
if my wife thinks proper to give up any of the Articles willed to
her them to be sold also. - I will that all the Money arising
from said sale and Debt due me be equally divided amongst
all my Daughters the Children of my daughter Molly Cobb shall have
their Mothers share that is her equal share with the rest of my Daughters
to be equally divided among all her Children.

I will that my wife shall have the Money life or hand but if she thinks
proper to give it up at any time it shall be equally divided
amongst all my Daughters my Daughter Molly Cobb's Children having
their part as aforesaid.

After the death of my wife I will that all the household fur-
-niture and all other Movable property be sold at public sale
the proceeds of said sale and debt due my Estate and Money
on hand be Equally divided amongst all my Daughters my Daughters
Molly's Children having her share as before.

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If any of my Daughters should die before they receive their share leaving no children
their share or shares to be equally divided amongst all the rest of my Daughters
or their heirs always. the Children of any One of them to have their Mothers part.

Executor of this my last Will & Testament.
