 Being now in my perfect Mind & Memory but Considering the
 Mortality of my Body and uncertainty of Our lives domake
 And Ordain this my last Will & Testament which is as follows (by)
 I Ordaine desire that First of all my Just Debts & funeral Charges
 Be fully satisfied out of my movable Estate - Item I will now
 Mention all my Daughters whiel I think I have portened of
 to nearly an equal Part of my Estate - Item I will
 & bequeath unto my Beloved wife Sarah Dillon all & every
 thing of my Estate Only such things as will remain After the
 Mentioned to have for her Own use or to distribute or give
 to any of Our Children as she may think proper But no
 Other Person so long as she liveth and Afterwards to be
 Sold at Public Sale or Auction & Equally Divided amongst the
 Children - I will now mention the Two Negroes Namely
 Rhoda & Tom which I leave to her will to Set free
 or keep in Bondage - Item I will & Bequeath unto my
 Son Peter Dillon as above mentioned After his Mother deceased
 a certain Tract or parcel of Land Lying on the Waters of
 Haw River wher Andrew Cain Deceased formerly lived it
 Being the Balance of the Tract I Gave Rachel Dillon One Hundred
 Acres of or Containing by Estimation Two Hundred Acres be the
 same more or less - Item I will & bequeath unto my Grand
 Son Jake Dillon or his for ever a Tract of Land Lying on the
 Waters of Buoy Creek adjoining Sanders Boro. Colleding
 wher Joseph Patterson now dwelleth But not to have a Right
 until After the Death of his Grand mother
 Item I will and desire that the Plantation where I now live
 Should be Sold at Public Sale & the money to be Equally
 Divided betwixt my Executors After the Death of my
 beloved Wife as above mentioned.

People of the Aforesaid State and County being Weak in body
but Still retaining the proper use of my Understanding & memory & Calling
to mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is Appointed unto
all men Once to die do hereby make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament, for the disposal of whatever Earthly
Goods it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow on me in this world
in the Following Manner & form that is to say

First I will that first of all that all my Just & Lawful debts shall be
faithfully and Justly discharged & paid out of my Estate And as
they are Considerable my Will is that my Negro Man Lewis Shall be Sold &
& that the sum of Four Hundred & fifty Dollars out of the amount arising
from the said Sale of the Said Lewis Shall first be paid to Joseph
Cummings who now has the Said Lewis in his Service at Work forth
Interest of the Said sum of \$150. And I further will that a Negro
boy named Edmund Also be Sold for the purpose of Discharging the
balance of my debts and in case the Sales of the two above named Negroes
Should not be sufficient to satisfy the whole then it is my Will
that so much of the Crop that shall be made on my Lands as can be spared
and so Many of the Stocks of Cattle as may be deemed necessary for that purpose
& Can be spared be likewise sold to finish & accomplish the payment of all my debts
Aforesaid PROVIDED nevertheless that if my dear wife Sally Phillips shall be found
