In the name of God Amen. This Twenty second day of March in the year of our Lord
 One Thousand eight hundred & Thirty- I Nathaniel HERR of the County of Guilford
 in the State of N. Carolina, being in a weak state as to bodily health, but of perfect
 mind & memory, do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is to say
 First I will that all my last debts that shall be by me owing at my death together
 with my funeral expenses, and all charges touching the proving of, or otherwise con-
 -cerning this my will shall out of my personal estate & effects be fully paid &
 satisfied; and from & after payment thereof & subject thereunto thereto -
 Secondly I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Hannah Herr, One negro Girl named
 Rebecca, One side saddle, One riding bridle, One Cape board & its furniture, One bed
 & furniture, One folding leaf table, One Walnut Chest, One Chair to be her favors
 Thirdly I will that my beloved wife Hannah Herr, my eldest Daughter Mahinda, my second
 Daughter Abigail, my third Daughter Elizabeth, and my son Samuel live together
 and have the use of the plantation on which I am now living together with
 the house, barn, and all other out houses, one Span Mare, One Waggon, & Cart, One
 Ox, One Mare, One iron wedge, all the plow, & hoe, all the Cattle, One Saddle,

One side of seat Coach, all the window Curtains, Carpets & Lills, One flax spinning wheel, One Cotton spinning wheel, One pair Cotton Cards, all the spun Cotton Thread & Wool, all the Clock, One side of upper Coach, together with all the Kitchen furniture until my son Samuel comes to the age of twenty one then I will that my beloved Wife Hannah Her have her Choice of One half of the dwelling house, One half of the barn, One half of the Out & the other Out houses, and a sufficient quantity of ground to maintain her during life.

Fourthly I will that as soon as my son Samuel arrives at the age of twenty one have One half of the dwelling house, half of the barn, and other out houses together with the balance of the Plantation until the death of his Mother; then I will that the whole of the Plantation be his forever.

Fifthly I will that my daughters Malinda, Louisa & Elizabeth have each one a bed & furniture.

Sixthly I will that my Negro boy Harry be put to the blacksmith trade, and as soon as he becomes a tolerable Smith to be hired out Annually until my Oldest Daughter Malinda arrives to the age of Eighteen years old; also my Negroes Jim & Abram, (after the present Cope is raised) I allow them to be hired out Annually until Malinda my Oldest Daughter arrives to the age of Eighteen.

Seventhly I will that my Daughters Malinda, Louisa & Elizabeth, and my son Samuel be schooled out of the money arising from notes on hand, book Accounts, and Sale, and the balance after paying my just debts to be added to the Unit of money arising from the hire of said Negroes Jim Abram & Harry.

Eighthly, I will that when my Oldest Daughter Malinda arrives at the age of Eighteen years old, receive one third of the Money on hand arising from the hire of Jim, Abram & Harry, and balance added after schooling Malinda Louisa Elizabeth & Samuel.

Ninthly I will that Jim, Abram & Harry continue to be hired out until my second Daughter Louisa arrives at the age of Eighteen years old, then she is to receive the same Amount of money my Oldest Daughter Malinda received at the age of Eighteen.

Tenthly I will that Jim, Abram & Harry continue to be hired out until Elizabeth comes to the age of Eighteen then she is to receive the same sum of Money that Malinda received.

Eleventhly, I will that when my youngest Daughter Elizabeth comes to the age of Eighteen years old, that she

Fourthly I will that as soon as my son Samuel arrives at the age of twenty one have

as soon as he becomes a tolerable Smith to be hired out annually until
my Oldest Daughter Malinda arrives to the age of Eighteen years old;
also my Negroes Jim & Abram, (after the present Crops is raised) I allow
them to be hired out annually until Malinda my Oldest Daughter arrives to the
age of Eighteen

Sixthly I will that my Daughter Malinda, Louisa & Elizabeth, and my son Samuel
be schooled out of the money arising from notes on hand, book Accounts,
and sale, and the balance after paying my just debts to be added to the
sum of money arising from the hire of said Negroes Jim Abram & Harry
Eighteen years old; when my Oldest Daughter Malinda arrives at the age of Eighteen
years old, receive one third of the money on hand arising from the hire of
Jim, Abram & Harry, and balance added after schooling Malinda Louisa
Elizabeth & Samuel.

Seventhly I will that Jim, Abram & Harry continue to be hired out until my second
Daughter Louisa arrives at the age of Eighteen years old, then she is to receive
the same amount of money my Oldest Daughter Malinda receives at the
age of Eighteen.
Eighthly I will that Jim, Abram & Harry continue to be hired out until Elizabeth
comes to the age of Eighteen then she is to receive the same sum of money
that Malinda received.
Ninthly I will that when my youngest Daughter Elizabeth comes to the age of
Eighteen years old that Jim Abram & Harry be sold & the money arising
from the balance of hire and sale of said Negroes be equally divided
between my three Daughters Malinda, Louisa, & Elizabeth.

Twelfthly I will that if any of my three Daughters Abigail, Venice & Elizabeth, or my son Samuel should die minors the surviving children shall be equal heirs.

Thirteenthly I will that as sufficiency of provisions be left for the family & felicity for the stock until sale & the balance to be sold.

Fourteenthly I will that one year provisions be laid off in the ensuing fall for the support of the family & provision for the stock.

Fifthteenthly and lastly I do hereby constitute make & Ordain my Brother Samuel Kerr, and my worthy friend Col James Kinney my Executors of this my last Will & Testament, and I do ratify & confirm this and no other to be my last Will & Testament - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day and date above Written

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Carby being about leaving the State of North Carolina, do grant & bestow my house & plantation in Currituck County N.C. consisting of One hundred & Twenty Two Acres and my house & plantation in Currituck Co. N.C. consisting of Two hundred & Twenty Seven Acres more or less to my nephew Thomas Carby, now residing in Greensborough Currituck Co. N.C. with all appurtenances thereto belonging; to hold, possess and manage said plantations as his own, provided neither of them be sold by me before my departure from N.C. But if the said Thomas should die without issue then his sister Judith Brown otherwise by birth Carby or her issue now residing in New York shall become right full heirs to said plantations. And all other property belonging to me in America I grant bestow, and bequeath to my said nephew and his heirs of issue to my said niece according to the above disposition.
