

I Nicholas Carter of the County of Guilford in the State of North Carolina being of sound mind & memory do on this 15th day of the second month in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty one make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows viz.

1st It is my will that all my just debt be paid with my personal charges by my executors as soon after my decease as may be practicable

2^d I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Adoliza Carter one half one bushel and half one bush & sixteenth one silver watch one silver spoon one set one oven one set of plates one set of knives & forks three bowls one set of kapes & success to be hers absolutely

3^d It is my will that my wife Adoliza shall have the sole and entire control and management of my home place whereon I now live for the benefit and use of herself and my daughter Rachel Carter untill the said Rachel becomes of age when if she remains to be my widow it is my will that she should have one half of my said home place but at any time if she should marry again or cease to be my widow it is my will that she shall then after have no further control of or interest in any other part of my estate than what is unconditionally bequeathed to her

4th I will and bequeath unto my daughter Rachel Carter fifty acres of wood Land lying north of Isaac Carter Lanes but if the proceeds of any part thereof should be needed for the support of my family or the education of my daughter it is my will

Knives & forks three bowls one set of cups & saucers to be hers absolutely
3^d It is my will that my wife Adeline shall have the sole and entire control and
management of my home place wherein I now live for the benefit and use of herself and
my daughter Rachel Carter untill the said Rachel becomes of age then of herself and
to be my widow it is my will that she should have one half of my same home place
But at any time if she should marry again or cease to be my widow it is my will
that she shall then after have no further control of or interest in any other part of
my estate than what is unconditionally bequeathed to her

4th I will and bequeath unto my daughter Rachel Carter fifty acres of wooded Land
lying north of Isaac Carter Lewis lot if the proceeds of any part thereof should be
needed for the support of my family or the education of my daughter it is my will
that my executor should sell the said fifty acres of wooded land and use such
part of the proceeds thereof as may be necessary for said support or education
and the balance if any together with such other parts of my estate as may not be
needed it is my will should be put to interest for the use & benefit of my
said daughter Rachel Carter
5th & lastly I ordain and appoint my beloved wife Adeline Carter and my
Brother John Carter executors to this my last will and testament hereby annulling

and foregoing all former and other wills by me made.
