I Pall Glass of the County of Guilford & State of North Carolina being in a Low State of Health, but by the blessing of God of Sound mind & memory & Considering the uncertainty of Life, & that it is appointed unto all men Once to die. Do hereby make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following That is to say my body I Commit to The dust from whence it was taken to be buried in a decent & Christian like manner, & my Soul to God Who gave it. And as to my worldly Goods I dispose of them in the following manner (Viz)

I Order & direct that all my Just debts be forthwith fairly & Honestly paid off. 1st I will & Bequeath to my beloved wife Eve One third part of the plantation wherein I ~~live~~ live during her natural life according as she may choose & laid off. with the House & Barn likewise one mare together with all my House hold & Kitchen furniture not hereafter otherwise disposed of Likewise two cows her choice Out of the stock & One Loom. 2nd I will & Bequeath to my dutiful son David Glass the remainder of the plantation wherein I live together with his mothers part at her death, conditional that he pay to his mother two Hundred Dollars when she shall demand the same. 3rd I will & Bequeath to my dutiful son John Glass One half of Certain lands Covered by two Deeds from William Jones and from Jacob Marshall. 4th I will & bequeath to my dutiful son Adam Glass the other half of the above ~~lands~~ lands Willed to John that is to Adam the upper part. 5th I will & Bequeath to my five daughters Namely Dolly Remer Mary Glass, Molly Glass, Eve Glass & Catherine Amick to each of them One hundred Dollars Likewise to my three daughters Molly Eve & Catherine I will Ten Dollars more to each of them in lieu of Certain Articles the Others got & them not.

6th I Order that my three Sons shall equally pay the above named money to their Sisters in consideration of the land they got. 7th I will & bequeath to my three daughters Molly Eve & Catherine to each of them two Cows & two Sheep. 8th I Order & direct that all my other property and a certain Tract of land Covered by a deed from Philip Amick be all sold at publick sale & Equally divided amongst all my heirs.

9th And lastly I appoint a Constable William Corbin & Nicholas Cable to be the Executors of this my last Will & Testament.
