And the residue of my estate both real and temporal to be appraised and divided in three parts. One third to my son John, and one third to my son Parris, and the other third to be equally divided between my two daughters Hannah & Mary Horney.

And I do hereby nominate and appoint my two sons John & Parris Chipman to be the Executors of this my last will and Testament, hereby disannulling all wills made by me heretofore. Ratifying this
