of Guilford and State of North Carolina being of sound
and perfect mind, and memory, do this 21st of 7th month
in the year of our Lord 1816. make and publish this
my last Will and Testament in manner following that

part of a tract of land, which descended to me from
my brother William Mendenhall, Decd. by or the heirs
of Morden back in the year of 1790, in North

Secondly I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Beulah
Mendenhall thirty five acres of land, by and thru
part of the above and first described tract

beginning in Nathan Hunt, line on the Corner above described
four rods South of the lower Spring. running from
thence South, with Nathan Hunt's line far enough to
make sharp across by turning West to Philb Mendenhall's
now line including the house and garden where the
Burial now lies

Thence I sell and convey unto my Daughter Philb Richards
all the Remain part of the first above described
tract of land which Benjamin Bay long acres and as
I have given unto my Daughter that now deceased son
Mary Kirtin and Jane Richards all that I intend them it
is my Will that their Children shall not have any
~~part of my~~ Estate. also my third son, Mordice Mendenhall
Let Mendenhall and Esar Mendenhall have
the full portion of our estate it is my Will
that they nor either of them shall not receive any
part of my present Estate.

And lastly I ordain and appoint my friend Zebulon
Hunt Executor to this my last Will and Testament
in Witness whereof I the said Philb Mendenhall have
signed this my hand and affixed my seal the day
