during her natural life, I Give & devise to my son John C Hornung
Two thirds of my land wherein I now live lying on the East side
of Bull Run to Come unto possession at the age of Twenty One
Years and the Other Third of Said Land at the decease of my said
Wife to him his heirs & assigns forever. I Give to my beloved Wife
Nancy Hornung my Woman Slave Called Grace also my Waggon &
hired Gurs my Gray Mare (Dove) & my black Mare, Two Cows &
Calves & all my Goods former & house hold & Kitchen Furniture
- 3rd I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Son Mantoe Hornung my Woman Slave Juda
- 4th I Give & bequeath to my three Sons Jeffry Samuel & Phillip Hornung my
Woman Slave Miriam Called (Miz) Equally between them forever
and my wish is that they do not sell her Out of the family
- 5th I Give & devise all my land lying on the West side of Bull Run
to my four Daughters Permeda Sally Anne & Terissa to be equally
divided between them & their heirs forever
- 6th I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Daughter Permeda my Woman Slave
Called (Lydia the Younger) One Cow & Calf Also One feather
Bed & Furniture worth Thirtys Dollars forever
- 7th I Give & bequeath to my Son John C Hornung my boy Slave (Lingo) One
Stots Colt One Cow & Calf also One feather bed & furniture worth
Thirty Dollars forever
- 8th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Sally my negro Slave Alice One Cow
& Calf also One feather bed & furniture worth Thirtys Dollars & a horse
worth Twenty Dollars forever
- 9th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Anne my negro Slave Salmons forever
& One Cow & Calf Also one feather Bed & furniture worth

Eight Hundred & Twenty make Ordain & Publish this my last
Will & Testament in manner following that is to say -

First My Will and desire is that all my Just Debts and Funeral
Charges Shall be paid Out of my ~~Personal~~ Estate

2nd I Give and devise to my beloved Wife Nancy Horning the whole of
my Land wherein I now live lying on the East side of Bull

of Bull Run to come unto possession at the age of Twenty One
Years and the Other Third of Said Land at the decease of my said
Wife to him his heirs & assigns forever. I Give to my beloved wife
Nancy Horning my Woman Slave Called Grace also my Waggon &
hired Curs my Gray Mare (Dove) & my black Mare, Two Cows &
Calves & all my Curs forever & household & Kitchen Furniture.

3rd I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Son Martha Horning my Woman Slave Judy

4th I Give & bequeath to my Three Sons Jeffrey Samuel & Phillip Horning my
Woman Slave Mariah Called (Miz) Equally between them forever
and my wish is that they do not sell her out of the family

5th I Give & devise all my Land lying on the West side of Bull Run
to my Four Daughters Permelia Sally Anne & Terissa to be equally
divided between them & their heirs forever

6th I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Daughter Permelia my Woman Slave
Called (Lydia the Younger) One Cow & Calf also One feather
Bed & Furniture worth Thirtys Dollars forever

7th I Give & bequeath to my Son John C Horning my boy Slave (Mingo) One
Horse, Colt One Cow & Calf also One feather bed & Furniture worth
Thirty Dollars forever

8th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Sally my negro Slave Alice One Cow
& Calf also One feather bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars & a horse
worth Twenty Dollars forever

9th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Anne my negro Slave Salmon forever
& One Cow & Calf Also one feather Bed & Furniture worth
Thirty Dollars & a Horse worth Seventy Dollars.

10th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Terissa my yellow Slave
(daughter of Miz) named Sarah One Cow & Calf also One feather

Anna
Sarah
Marie

I did & furniture worth Thorty Dollars & a Horse worth Twenty Dollars
forwar.

10th I Give & bequeath to my beloved Wife & all my Children, Manlove
Jeffrey, Samuel Phillips, Pamela, John G, Sally, Anna & Terisa
the remainder of my Neat Cattle forwar to be equally divided between
them.

11th I Give & bequeath to my beloved Wife & Children Pamela, John G,
Sally, Anna & Terisa all of my Sheep & Swine to be Equally to
be divided between them.

12th I Give & bequeath to my four sons, Manlove Jeffrey, Samuel &
Phillips my Cattle Equally between them,

13th I leave my Slave (George) to remain in my family to work
the farm for the support of my wife & my five youngest children
until the youngest shall arrive at the age of eighteen & then to
serve in the family two years after my daughter Terisa is
Eighteen Years Old & then to have a New suit of Clothes & be free
at Liberty & not to be under the control of any of my heirs nor after
nor any claiming under me or them. The Child with which my Slave
Juda is pregnant now I give & bequeath whom (Born whether male
or female to my son John G Horning forever. My Will is that my children
have reasonable Priviledges of my House Garden & Orchard so long as they live
single. My Will and desire is that if any disagreement should
take place in any way respecting my Estate that the MasterChancier
and different Men to settle the same and that an Award of one
Men so chosen be as binding as the Ordicel of a Jury.

I appoint my son Jeffrey & my daughter Pamela as my Executors
of my Estate of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all of former
Wills by me made. ^{Thorty} Yearly ratifying & Confirming this my
Last Will & Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto

In the Name of God Amen I Martha Leeky of the County of Guilford & State of North Carolina being at present Sick & Weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to god & Calling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is Appointed for all One to die, and do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament That is to say principally & first of all I Give & Recommend my Soul unto the Hand of Almighty God that Gave it & my body I Recommend to Earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the mighty power of God that Gave it me and as Touching Larks Wordly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me in this Life, I Give & Devise & Dispose of the same in the Following Manner & forme

I am I Give & bequeath to my Neffew Col. Walter McConnell One Bed with all its furniture also One Desk & Book Case & his Choice of the Two Tables

Also his Choice of Two head of cattle out of the Stock also one third part of all my Dresser Table & Kitchen Furniture, I am I Give & bequeath to Margaret Stewart, One Bed with all the furniture therunto belonging also One third of all my Dresser Table & Kitchen Furniture also all my Weaving Apparel of Every Kind, I am I Give & bequeath to Adam Lecky Stewart, One Bed of furniture also at my death if I shall be in Possession of a horse or mare that to be Adam Lecky Stewart but if there should be neither of either kind the sum of Sixty Dollars in money

Also his Uncle Wm's Chest also One Cow one 2 year Old Bull & One Year Old -- I am I Give to Adam Lecky Stewart One third part of all my Kitchen Dresser & Furniture -- I am I Give to Adam Lecky Stewart One Negro Girl named Cimie aged sixteen years
