2nd I Give and devise to my beloved Wife Nancy Hornum the whole of my land whereon I now live lying on the East side of Bull Run until the time at which my Son John C Hornum may arrive at the age of Twenty One Years then One Third of Said Land to be during her natural life, I Give & devise to my Son John C Hornum Two thirds of my land whereon I now live lying on the East side of Bull Run to Come unto possession at the age of Twenty One Years and the Other Third of Said Land at the decease of my said Wife to him his heirs & assigns forever. I Give to my beloved Wife Nancy Hornum my Woman Slave called Grace also my Waggon & hind Curs my Gray Mare (Dove) & my black Mare, Two Cows & Calves & all my Guns for ever & house hold & Kitchen Furniture

3rd I Give & bequeath to my Oldst Son Manlove Hornum my Woman Slave Jude

4th I Give & bequeath to my Three Sons Jeffery Samuel & Phillips Hornum my Woman Slave Miriam called (Miz) Equally between them forever and my Wish is that they do not Sell her Out of the family

5th I Give & devise all my land lying on the West side of Bull Run to my four Daughters Permelia Sally Anne & Thirisa to be equally divided between Share & Share alike to them & their heirs forever

6th I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Daughter Permelia my Woman Slave called (Lydia the Younger) One Cow & Calf also One feather Bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars forever

7th I Give & bequeath to my Son John C Hornum my boy Slave (Mingo) One Horse Coll One Cow & Calf also One Feather bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars forever

8th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Sally my negro Slave Alice One Cow & Calf also One feather bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars & a horse worth Twenty Dollars forever

9th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Anne my negro Slave Salimico forever & One Cow & Calf also one feather Bed & Furniture worth

Eight Hundred & Twenty make Ordain & Publish this my last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say. —

First My Will and desire is that all my Just Debts and funeral

Charges shall be paid Out of my ~~Personal~~ ^{Personal} Estate

2nd I Give and devise to my beloved Wife Nancy Horny the whole of my Land whereon I now live lying on the East side of Bull Run until the time at which my Son John C Horny, may arrive at the age of Twenty One Years then One Third of Said Land to her during her natural life, I Give & devise to my Son John C Horny Two thirds of my Land whereon I now live lying on the East side of Bull Run to Come unto possession at the age of Twenty One Years and the Other Third of Said Land at the decease of my said Wife to him his heirs & assigns forever. — I Give to my beloved Wife Nancy Horny my Woman Slave Called Grace also my Wagon & hind Curs my Gray Mare (Dove) & my black Mare, Two Cows & Calves & all my Curs forever & house hold & Kitchen Furniture

3rd I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Son Manlove Horny my Woman Slave Jude

4th I Give & bequeath to my Three Sons Jeffery Samuel & Phillips Horny my Woman Slave Miriam Called (Miz) Equally between them forever and my Wish is that they do not Sell her Out of the family

5th I Give & devise all my Land lying on the West side of Bull Run to my four Daughters Permelia Sally Anne & Terrisa to be equally divided between Share & Share alike to them & their heirs forever

6th I Give & bequeath to my Oldest Daughter Permelia my Woman Slave Called (Lydia the Younger) One Cow & calf also One feather Bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars forever

7th I Give & bequeath to my Son John C Horny my boy Slave (Mingo) One Horse Colt One Cow & calf also One feather bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars forever

8th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Sally my negro Slave Alice One Cow & calf also One feather bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars & a horse worth Twenty Dollars forever

9th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Anne my negro Slave Salmeo forever & One Cow & calf also one feather Bed & Furniture worth Thirty Dollars & a horse worth Twenty Dollars

10th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Terrisa my yellow Slave (daughter of Miz) named Sarah One Cow & calf also One feather

And furniture worth Thirty Dollars & a Horse worth Twenty Dollars
forwards

10th I Give & bequeath to my beloved Wife & all my Children, Manlove
Jeffery Samuel Phillips Pamela, John G, Sally, Anna & Terrisa
the remainder of my Real Estate forwards to be equally divided between
them.

12th I Give & bequeath to my beloved Wife & Children Pamela John G,
Sally Anna & Terrisa all of my Sheep & Swine to be Equally to
be divided between them

13th I Give & bequeath to my four sons, Manlove Jeffery, Samuel &
Phillips my Estate Equally between them.

14th I leave my Slave (George) to remain in my family to work
the farm for the support of my Wife & my five youngest children
until the youngest shall arrive at the age of Eighteen & then to
serve in the family Two Years After my daughter Terrisa is
Eighteen Years Old & then to have a New suit of Clothes & be free
& at Liberty & not to be under the Control of any of my heirs or after
Nor any claiming under me or them - The Child with which my Slave
Juda is pregnant now I give & bequeath when Born whether male
or female to my son John G. Horsey forever. My Will is that my children
have reasonable Privilege of my House Garden & Orchard so long as they live
Single - My Will and desire is that if any disagreement should
take place in any way respecting my Estate that the parties choose
indifferent Men to settle the same and that an Award of such
Men so Chosen be as binding as the Verdict of a Jury -

I appoint my son Jeffery & my daughter Pamela my Executors of
my Estate & of this my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking all former
Wills by me made - Truly Testifying & Confirming this my
Last Will & Testament - In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Affixed my seal the day & Year above mentioned

In the Name of God Amen I Martha Leckey of the County of Gulford & State of North Carolina being at present Sick & Weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God & Calling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for all One to die, and do Make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament That is to say Principally & first of all I Give & Recommend my Soul unto the Hand of Almighty God that Gave it & my body I Recommend to Earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I Shall Receive the Same again by the Mighty Power of God that Gave it me and as Touching Such Wordly Estate where with it hath pleased God to Bless me in this Life, I Give Dispose & dispose of the Same in the Following Manner of orme

I Give & bequeath to my Nephew Colo Walter McConnell One Bed with all its Furniture also One Oak & Book Case, & his Choice of the Two Tables Also his Choice of Two head of Cattle Out of the Stock Also one third part of all my Dresser Table & Kitchen Furniture, I Give & bequeath to Margurat Stuart, One Bed with all the Furniture thereunto belong Also One third of all my Dresser Table & Kitchen Furniture also all my Wearing Apparel of Every Kind, I Give & bequeath to Adam Lackey Stuart, One Bed & Furniture also at my death if I shall be in possession of a horse or mare that to to Adam Lackey Stuart but if there should be neither of Either Kind the Sum of Sixty Dollars in money Also his Uncle's Walnut Chest Also One Cow one 2 Year Old Steer & One Year Old - I Give to Adam Lackey Stuart, One third part of all my Kitchen Dresser & Furniture - I Give to Adam Lackey Stuart, One negro Girl Named Ginepp Aged Sixteen
