unto all One to die do hereby make and publish this my Last Will
and Testament in manner & Form following Viz. My Body I Commit
to the dust from whence it was Taken & my Soul to God who Gave it
and as to my worldly Goods I Dispose of them in the following
Manner that is to say I Order & Direct All my Just Debts to be
forthwith fairly paid off & the Remainder I make the following Dispo-
-sitions 1st I Will and Bequeath to my Son Robert Stewart an
Negro Girl named Ruth & One Chest of Drawers 2 I Will & Bequeath
To my Son John Stewart One half part of Three volumes of Scots
family Bibles the Other half part to my Son Robert 3 I Will &
Bequeath to my Daughter Susan Clark One Negro Girl ^{named} _{named}
Constitutional that she pay to the Heirs of my Son James Stewart
Out of the sum of five hundred & five Dollars Likewise One Negro
Woman named Jane & One boy her child named Andy the boy
& Andy I Give out & Accompanied to my said Daughter for her
Taken Care of Supporting 1st Negro Woman in her Old age. Also
Also one volume of Scots family Bible on the said Testament
4th I Will & Bequeath to my Daughter Ephraim Correll One horse by
Choice of all I may the Heirs of the Deceased the 2^d Volume of
Scots family Bible on the said Testament
5th I Will & Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Hamers
One Negro Girl named Jane & One Copper Caskboards
6th I Will & Bequeath to my other four ^{grand} children children
of my Daughter Judith McAdams to each of them five
Dollars
7th I Will & Bequeath to my Grandsons Sordley Washington
Correll & Timothy Stewart Also Equally Likewise their

The proceeds of one Acre of One Hundred Acres on French Creek
of the Well and Bequeath to my three Grandsons Robert Stuart Stewart
John Stewart & James Stewart & I desire Stewart, son to John
Stewart to each of them fifty Dollars to be paid Out of the sales of
my property

10th I Order & direct that all my property not ~~here~~ before disposed
of be Sold at publick Sale and the amount together with Three
Notes viz. One on William Garrison of ten Hundred Dollars & One of
Twenty Eight Dollars & One on Judith Smith of one Hundred &
Twenty Six Dollars be all equally divided amongst my Children
The Children of my Son James to have amongst them an Equal Share
with my Other Children But the Children of my Daughter Judith
Widow are Excepted & forbade any part Other than what I have
before named to them

11th I Order & direct that my Negro Woman Pove have priviledge to take
with her her Own Spinning Wheel her Chest & Bed.

12th And Lastly I constitute appoint & name my son Robert Stuart
& John Stewart & my son in Law David Correll to be the
faithfull Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my Seal this 15th of May A.D. 1810

faithful Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my Seal this 15th of May A.D. 1819
