I hereby constitute & appoint Nathan Collenderhall my Executor to this my last Will & Testament.

Lastly It is my Will that my Executor do shall pay my three said children each alike share of what shall remain in his hands of my Pension After paying my last debts & funeral charges not in money but each of them the Value of Ten dollars a year in such things as they need for food & clothing.
