

I do it remembered that I Richard Day Lord of
the County of Guilford & State of North Carolina
being of Sound & perfect mind do make & ordain
this my last Will and Testament that as to
Say I Will and bequeath that my Executors sell
all my land to the highest bidder in one or two
lots at their own discretion on a Credit of
one and two years and that the money arising
from the sale thereof be divided as follows
to wit One Half to my Son Richard Day and
the other half to be equally divided that is
to say one third to my daughter Deborah
Haworth one third to my daughter Mary
Anderson and the remaining third to the
Natural born children of my daughter Rhoda
Remondy Co. Shaw and Shaw alike I
Further Will and bequeath that my said
Executors sell all my personal estate to
the highest bidder and that out of the
personal proceeds of the sale thereof they
give unto my Son Richard Day the Sum of
Ten Dollars and that the residue of the
proceeds of my personal estate be divided
in three equal Shares to wit one third to my
daughter Deborah Haworth one third to my
daughter Mary Anderson and the remaining
third to the said children of Rhoda
Remondy except four dollars which I Will
to my Son William Day he having heretofore
received a full portion of my Estate
and lastly I ordain and appoint Joseph
Hunt & Zebulon Hunt Executors to this my
last Will & Testament Witness my hand
and Seal this 6th day of the 2nd month

following to be my last Will & Testament.

Chest & Two Hundred Dollars to be paid to her
in bonds which I now hold on my son Rector Dick.
Secondly I Devise to my son Abram Campbell Dick
I Give here forever the tract of land on which
I now live lying on the North side of the little
Allamance containing about one hundred and
Twenty five acres, also twenty three acres adjoining
the same which I purchased of John & Elizabeth
McMurry also thirty acres of land on the
East side of Rock Creek which I purchased
of Andrew Agnew also twenty five acres of
land on the South side of the little Allamance
lying between the Rock branch & Burn Charly-
low being originally a part of the tract of land
on which I now live - all of which said
lands are left to my wife Mary
