Secondly I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Gardner the whole of my Estate both Real & Personal for and during the time of her remaining the widow of my Body and if she should marry it is my will that she have the One half of my personal Estate & Household furniture & at her marriage or death I leave ^{unto my} brother Noziah Gardners Children my Real Estate and the Remains of my Personal Estate to be equally divided among them to them and their several heirs and Assigns forever - And Lastly I appoint my Beloved Brother Jonathan Gardner & Joseph Coffin Joint Executors of this my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this fourth day of the first month One thousand Eight Hundred & Eighteen.
